What is the Annual Giving Drive & what does it support?

The Annual Giving Drive is an annual effort to solicit stewardship pledges and financial support from church members for the upcoming year. The funds from this drive provide roughly 2/3 of St. John's Operating Budget.

What is a pledge?

A pledge is a commitment to make a monetary donation to the church at regular intervals during the year to come. Pledges help us build a budget for the upcoming year.

How do I make a pledge?

Fill out a Pledge Card and mail it to St. John's, place it in the Offering Plate on Sunday, or bring it to the Church Offices. Or, visit our website www.stjohnsjackson.org and click on the "Donate" button on the left-hand side on the homepage.

How do I pay?

Pledges or contributions can be paid as a single gift or in installments: weekly, monthly, quarterly or annually. Your pledge can be in the form of cash, check, credit card or direct debit payment. Payments can be made securely online, by mail, in the Offering Plate, or by contacting Greer Terry.

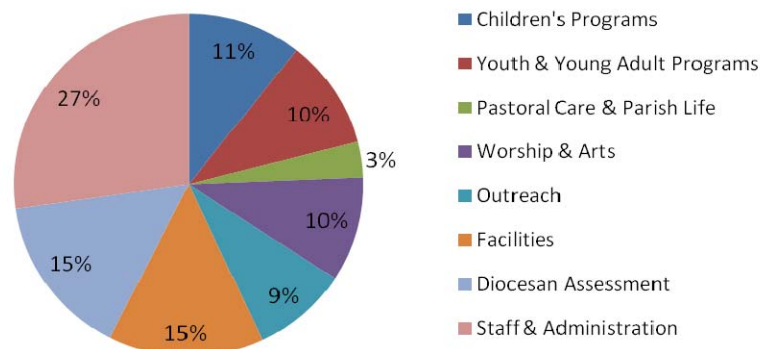
Your pledge allows us to plan for 2012 and responsibly carry out God's work in Jackson Hole.
